CONDITIONS FOR THE GOOD HANDS QUALIFYING CLASS

Conditions for judging The Good Hands qualifying class are as follows:

For Junior riders who have not reached their 18th birthday. To be judged as a group at a walk, trot and canter. A minimum of <u>two riders</u> are required to individually execute a figure eight at a canter, trot back to judge, stop and back. After which USEF tests 1-16 may be called for (see USEF Rule Book for details of tests). Horsemanship only to count. Judging is based 40% on rail work; 60% on the workout. To fill a class, two competitors must show with proper tack.

ELIGIBILITY FOR THE GOOD HANDS FINALS

To be eligible to compete in The Good Hands Junior Exhibitor Finals, entrant must have placed first or second in an official qualifying class from October 15th to October 15th of the following year. One win eliminates a rider from further competition in this class for the remainder of the qualifying season.

To be eligible to compete in <u>The Good Hands Adult Finals</u> riders, age 18 and over, must have exhibited in at least one Adult Equitation Class during the qualifying season. They do not have to win or place for eligibility.

A winner of The Good Hands Junior Exhibitor Finals is not eligible for further participation in any Good Hands classes for that age division.

A winner of the Adult Good Hand Finals is ineligible for the following year competition but can return in two (2) years.

CLASS RESULTS

The enclosed results form is sent for the convenience of the show secretary and <u>must be</u> <u>returned within ten days</u> of the show along with the class sheet showing the entries and their placements to insure the prompt and proper certification of the first and second place winners.
